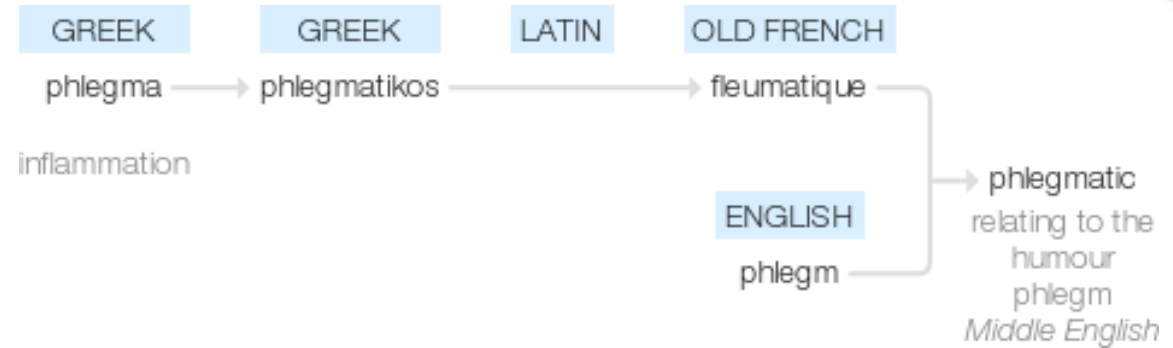

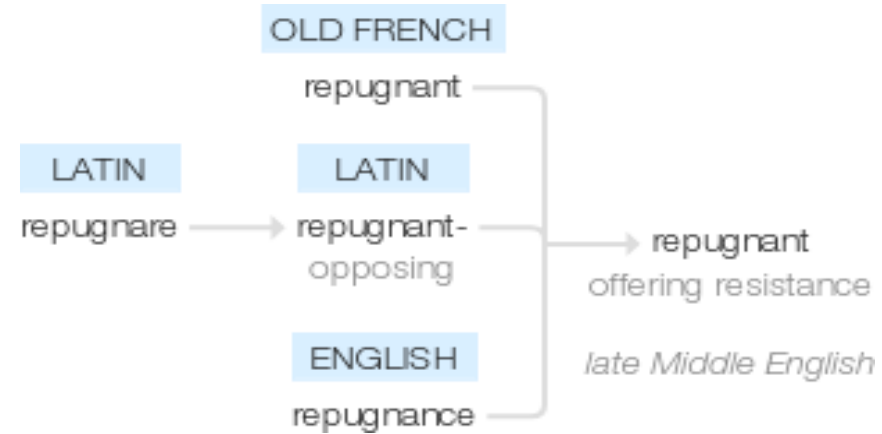
Phlegmatic



Word Class	Adjective
Meaning	Having an unemotional or calm disposition
Examples	His ability to be phlegmatic is clearly an asset.
	It was a strangely phlegmatic response to what should have been good news
	A most phlegmatic man, he pushed on despite difficulty
Synonyms for this word	Impassive, stoical, apathetic, cold, reserved, unemotional

Summer Week 2

Repugnant



Word Class	Adjective
Meaning	Extremely distasteful or unacceptable
Examples	The act of cannibalism is simply repugnant.
	I find your attitude towards these people quite repugnant.
	From the chamber came the most repugnant smell.
Synonyms for this word	Abhorrent, disgusting, loathesome, abominable, obscene

Quintessential

Word Class	<i>Adjective</i>
Meaning	Being the most typical example or most important part of something.
Examples	1. Around the world, tea is considered the quintessential British beverage.
	2. St Ives is a quintessential sea side town.
	3. School ties are the quintessential piece of any school uniform.
Synonyms for this word	classic, exemplary, perfect, archetypical, archetypal, definitive, excellent, unique

Summer Week 5



Gruelling

Word Class	<i>Adjective</i>
Meaning	extremely tiring and demanding
Examples	1. My revision plan was gruelling but the exam results made it worthwhile.
	2. After the gruelling climb, the view is breathtaking.
	3. The school holidays are always a welcome respite after a gruelling term.
Synonyms for this word	Arduous, punishing, exhausting, laborious.

Narcissistic

Morphology – structure of words



Word Class	Adjective
Meaning	Extremely self-centered with an exaggerated sense of self importance: marked by or characteristic of excessive admiration of or infatuation with oneself.
Examples	Narcissistic people have a hard time seeing another person's point of view.
	I found her to be narcissistic and self-sorbed.
	I thik that he has narcissistic tendencies but he disagree
Synonyms for	Vein, self-loving, egotistic, conceited

Diligence

Morphology – structure of words



Word Class	Noun
Meaning	Steady in application, industrious, attentive to duties
Examples	GCSE students show diligence in their revision planning to ensure future success.
	Many checks were undertaken to show due diligence before buying a used car.
	Diligence was shown by geography students whilst out their fieldwork.
Synonyms for this word	vigour, intensity, attentiveness

Gregarious

Morphology – structure of words



Word Class	<i>Adjective</i>
Meaning	Liking to be with other people
Examples	1. She joined a book club to meet people because she is gregarious and enjoys talking with others.
	2. His gregarious personality made him the perfect host, ensuring everyone felt welcome at his gatherings.
	3. The gregarious dolphins swam close to the tour boat, much to the delight of the passengers eager for interaction
Synonyms for this word	Social Affable Friendly Extroverted Outgoing
